WAYS TO SUPPORT THE IRC

You can support the Indianapolis Radio Club in any, or all, of these four ways:

- 1. Join the club. ARRL DXCC SYSTEM BACK UP, MOSTLY (FINALLY)

The ARRL DXCC® System has been returned to service, and our staff is again processing applications for credit toward DXCC awards. The queue includes nearly 3,000 award applications submitted via Logbook of The World® (LoTW®) accounts and mailed paper applications. We are processing the backlog as quickly as possible, and will provide additional progress updates.

For now, the online DXCC application will remain offline. Any new award applications we receive will experience significant delays as we work through the backlog.

As previously reported, LoTW® was returned to service on Monday, July 1, 2024. Since then, the system has been processing log uploads with little or no processing delay.

We are grateful for your continued patience and understanding as we continue to make progress on the few remaining services that have required additional attention to bring back online.

CQ WORLD-WIDE SSB DX CONTEST THIS WEEKEND

If you have access to an HF station and are looking for some good DX contacts, try to get on this weekend for the CQ World-Wide SSB DX Contest. Even if you don't have a General Class license yet, you can still operate on 10 meters from 28.300 to 28.500, and 10 meters has been in pretty good shape lately. The contest starts at 0:00 UTC, Saturday (8:00 pm Friday evening, Indy time), and goes through 23:59:59 UTC Sunday (call it 8:00 pm Sunday evening, Indy time). It's a simple exchange, just a signal report (59) and your CQ Zone (all of Indiana is Zone 4). For all the rules and information, point your browser to https://cqww.com/rules.htm

Signals from the Past:

From the October, 1964 Amachewer:

Excerpt from "RECOLLECTIONS OF THE FIRST MEETING"

Quoting one of the founding members of the Indianapolis Radio Club, Harry Silcox, ex-9EE: "You might wonder where we got the wire to make transformers. We used wire from bell ringers--old ones from the telephone company. We had an engineer friend in the telephone company who tipped us off where the junked equipment was going--to a junk yard on McCarty Street. The fellow there would let us have the run of the place. We'd pick out a pile of stuff for maybe \$.50. It was 32 or 36 silk covered wire on the ringers. We used a whale of a lot of it making pancakes for 1 KW transformers."
